MARY CHAPIN CARPENTER TO APPEAR AT LBC

The Luther Burbank Center for the Arts is proud to announce that Grammy-award winning singer/songwriter Mary Chapin Carpenter will perform a special acoustic show at the LBC on Sunday, October 25.

Mary Chapin Carpenter's songs of life and love have touched the hearts of audiences across the nation, and crossed musical borders from country to pop to folk. Since the 1987 release of her debut album *Hometown Girl*, she has made the climb up the *Billboard* charts multiple times, with Top Ten hits such as **I Feel Lucky**, **The Bug**, **Passionate Kisses** and **Shut Up and Kiss Me**. Chapin Carpenter's ability to blend genres is exquisitely portrayed on her 1990 Number One single **Down at the Twist and Shout** – a rockin' mix of country, pop and soul, flavored with a generous dash of New Orleans spice provided by seminal Cajun band Beausoleil.

Chapin Carpenter made Grammy history in 1994 as the only country artist to have won four Grammys in a row in the same category – Best Country Vocal Performance. And her hit single **He Thinks He'll Keep Her** was nominated for Record of the Year in 1995, only the second time in Grammy history that a nomination in this coveted category has gone to a country artist.

Experience the music of Mary Chapin Carpenter in the intimate setting of the Luther Burbank Center on October 25. Opening the show will be folk-rock favorite Catie Curtis.
